

Year 2 Home Learning - Summer Term 2

Below you will find 5 different activities for your child to complete as Home Learning. Choose one activity to submit each week, however, by the end of the first half of the summer term (by Wednesday 11th July 2018) they must have submitted ALL 5 activities. These should be completed in their Home Learning books. The resources you need can be found in the 'Home Learning' section of the Year 2 class page on the school website, together with a copy of this Home Learning letter. **Please ask if you require hard copies of any of the documents.**

Maths - Addition/Subtraction/Multiplication/Division

In Maths we are using what we have learnt and applying strategies to solve problems and develop our reasoning. This involves **missing box problems**. Complete the Maths problem sheet by thinking carefully about which operation you need to use to find the answer: $\times/\div/ +/ -$. Please choose one sheet; either bronze, silver or gold (as appropriate).



AFRICA

Geography/Art - Maasai People

In Geography we have been learning all about Kenya, including the Maasai people. We have considered how their homes are different to our own homes in Surrey. In your books, draw a picture of a typical Kenyan/Maasai home/village. Then, draw a contrasting picture of a typical home in Horley/Surrey. It would be good if you labelled your drawings with the key features!

Maths - Shape

We have been exploring properties of different 2D and 3D shapes. We have been using our shape knowledge to sort everyday objects into their corresponding 3D shape. Fill out the grid by drawing pictures of everyday objects you can find for each of the 3D shapes listed. How many can you find? Which shape is the most common?

Science/Geography - Giraffes

In Science, we have been learning about animals and their habitats. Complete the 'All About Giraffes' activity sheet. Also try to complete the challenges! Please do only one of the activities, not all 3 sheets, i.e. choose either the 1*, the 2* or the 3* activity! It is recommended that you try the 3* activity.

History/English - David Livingstone

We will be learning about David Livingstone this half term, the famous Scottish explorer. Undertake your own research at home, then write up what you learn about him. Try to extend your sentences with conjunctions, suffix words and adjectives. Remember to include the punctuation you have been learning in school, e.g. commas, exclamation marks and apostrophes.
