


## Year 1 Home Learning – Autumn Term 2 - 2018

Below you will find different activities for your child to complete as Home Learning. It must be submitted each Monday so that it can be marked and returned each Wednesday. Please note that if Home Learning is handed in after the deadline it will not be marked that week. The children can choose which activity to submit each week; however, by the end of the autumn term (by Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December) they must have completed and handed in ALL activities. Home learning should be completed in the children's Home Learning books (on either a blank or lined page, as appropriate). For some of the activities you will find resources under the 'Home Learning' section of the Year 1 page on the school website. The Home Learning books will not be sent home over holiday periods except in specific circumstances.

### Maths—Addition and Subtraction on a number line

On the Year 1 page, please find a Hodgeheg addition and subtraction counting sheet. Please encourage your child to look carefully to see if they need to add or subtract then draw the correct amount of hops. Once finished please can you encourage your child to stick into their book neatly.

### **Animals and Ourselves**



### English – Adjectives

As part of our animals topic we have focused on the story of The Hodgeheg by Dick King Smith. We are encouraging children to recognise and use adjectives (describing words) and nouns (person, place or thing). On the Year 1 page please find a nouns and adjectives sheet where they need to colour the adjectives green and the nouns blue.

### Science

Our story is about a hedgehog. Draw and label a hedgehog and find a fact about it (i.e. What does it like to eat? Where does it live? Is it a herbivore or a carnivore? Why does it have spikes?)

### PSHCE

As part of our topic on keeping ourselves safe we would like the children to look out for pedestrian crossings on the road. Discuss how to cross the road safely. Then draw and label a pedestrian crossing i.e zebra crossing, pelican crossing, toucan crossing.

### Music

We will be learning Christmas Songs over the coming weeks; please can you encourage your child to learn the words. We will send home lyrics for you to rehearse at home! This is ongoing home learning- it does not need to be submitted!

**Spelling:** Each week your child will receive a list of spelling words and will be tested every Friday. These will be sent out with their homework on a Wednesday. These do not need to be returned to school and please keep them at home so the children have the opportunity to consolidate.
