<b>Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December</b> <b>Mufti day in exchange for your generous donations</b>	Baked Goods	Please donate baked goods for the Cake Stall (shop bought or home-made). Cookies for the Refreshments stall, or anything else, including peppermint creams, shortbread, truffles... all welcome.

There will be a Donation Station in the playground area on each of the days for donations (except baked goods, which should be taken directly to area outside the Library on Friday). Collections will be taken throughout the week!
