Reminders

Book Bag & Water Bottle – Please remember to bring your book bag and a named water bottle to school every day.

Coats – As the weather is unpredictable, please ensure your child has a coat with them each day.

Reading – Please continue to hear your child read on a daily basis and record this in their reading diary. Please ensure you are giving your child the opportunity to read to you, to allow them to develop their reading skills. We collect reading diaries in on a Monday and award STARS Points for regular reading. Remember, as well as the Rhino Reader book, other reading materials can be used to enhance your child's love of reading.

Home learning – Children are required to:

- · Read daily
- Play Numbots 20 minutes a week
- Practise weekly spellings
- Complete 4 home learning tasks per half term.

(Spellings will be set on a Thursday and quizzed on the following Thursday).

Curriculum

Our theme for Spring 1 is 'The History of Transport'. In this first half term, some of the books that we will be focussing on in Whole Class Reading and English are The Train Ride, Oi Get Off Our Train, The Hundred Decker Bus and The Snail and the Whale. In History, we are going to be learning about The Wright Brothers and George Stephenson and how they impacted transport.

Our theme for Spring 2 is 'Plants', where we will be learning about a variety of common flowers and plants, including trees and identifying their structure. Some of the books that we will be focussing on in Whole Class Reading and English are Jack and the Jelly Bean Stalk, The Tiny Seed and Little Sunflower. In this half term, the children will be growing their own seeds in hope that the produce will be used during 'Health Week' in the Summer term. We are also going to get creative and produce artwork inspired by Kandinsky and Van Gogh!

PE

Year 1 have PE on a **Monday**, **Tuesday** and **Wednesday** and PE kit should be worn into school on these days. Please ensure that your child has a complete kit including a Langshott t-shirt, navy jogging bottoms / shorts and trainers. Please name everything!
