Reading

Please make sure to read with your child daily. Your child will be given a wordless text for you to look through with them. When they receive their first Rhino Reader book, please ensure they read to you to allow them to develop their reading skills. They will also choose a reading for pleasure picture book from the class library which they will change daily. Make sure to record reads in their reading record. We collect reading records in on a **Monday** and award regular STARS Points for reading.

Book Bag & Water Bottle

Please make sure your child brings their book bag and filled and named water bottle to school every day.


PE


PE will take place every Wednesday. The children will need to keep their PE kits at school as they will get changed here.

Milk


If your child would like to have a daily milk carton, please enquire at www.coolmilk.com.
