Things to Remember

Reading:

It is important that you read with your child on a **daily basis**. We collect in reading diaries on a **Monday** and award STARS Points according to the number of reads recorded each week.

Home Learning:

The children will be required to complete the following:

- Daily reading
- Practise spellings at home, ready for the quiz each Thursday
- Half-termly home learning
- •• Numbots as part of the transition into Year 2, we will be continuing with Numbots for the first half term.

Autumn Term PE:

The children will be participating in a Dance unit and learning to play invasion games. PE will be on **Thursday** and **Friday** each week. Please ensure your child is wearing the appropriate PE kit on those days.

Forest School:

We will be taking part in Forest School on a **Tuesday** morning. These sessions will run up to the October half term. We will keep their Forest School kit in the classroom.

Curriculum:

English and Reading	We are using <i>The Tin Forest</i> to launch our writing in Year 2. Linked to our history topic of the Great Fire of London, we will be creating a diary entry and composing some fire poetry. We will also be writing our own creative stories based on <i>Little Red Reading Hood</i> . During our reading lessons, we will be looking at the books <i>Here We Are</i> and <i>Stick Man</i> .
Twinkl Phonics and Rhino Readers	We will be continuing to follow the Twinkl phonics and reading scheme, including Rhino Readers to help and support children's learning and development.
Maths	We will be starting the term with place value, progressing to addition and subtraction. Later on this term, we will also move onto multiplication, division and money.
Science	Our focus this term will be all about different <i>Uses of Everyday Materials</i> .
Foundation	Our foundation topics are as follows:
	 In Art, we will learn about Pablo Picasso and create our own clay self-portraits. In Geography, we will be looking at Horley and where we live. In History, we will be learning about The Great Fire of London. In DT, we will be making our own 3D structures, related to the Great Fire of London. In RE, we will be learning about Christianity and the Christmas story. In Music, we will be learning how to use the Boomwhackers and we will improve our vocal skills.
