## Treasurer's report for the year ended 31 August 2023

## Highlights:

- 1 Total income raised up vs. prior year at £17,222
- 2 Xmas Fair being the highest event, raising £6,848. (The raffle was £1,827 and silent auction £1,700)
- Other Xmas income included
- Father Xmas Letters: £295
- Xmas Performance: £139
- 3 London Marathon was another big income at £3,227
- 4 Summer Fair earned ~£600 more than the previous year at £1,648
- 5 Significant increase in funds raised through the Mufti-Days. This raised £1,119. ~£800 more than last year
- 6 Disco income overall is £555. (£804 for the Main Disco, less Year 6 leavers Disco expense at £249)
- 7 Return of the Quiz Nights. This earned £507
- 8 Uniform Sales remainded flat for the past 3 years at just under £400
- 9 Total Easter income: £588
  - Easter Egg Hunt returned through Friends: £311
  - Easter Cake sales: £277
- 10 Dare to be Different: £309
- 11 Other Cake Sales earned £307
- 12 Costume/Jumper Sales New income raised £119
- 13 Total Payments/Contributions to the school was £14,160. Up £6,249 from the previous year
