Our Curriculum

English

This term, our English lessons will be inspired by WWII. We will be developing our skills as writers, focusing on: using dialogue to move the action on; using the passive voice and learning to use colons and semi colons to punctuate our work. Over the term, we will be writing narratives, instructions and poetry.

Mathematics

Our focus will be on fractions, decimals and percentages. If you want to do any extra learning with your child, there are booklets on the website organised by topic.

Science

To being with, we will be studying electricity. As we move through the Spring Term, we will take part in British Science week! The theme for the week is living things where we will be covering our science unit exploring living things and their habitats.

Online Safety

In February, it is Safer Internet Day and the theme is 'Making a difference, managing influence and navigating change online'. The children will have the option to complete a task as part of their spring home learning, but we will also be looking at ways to keep ourselves safe online and have lots of discussions around this topic.

Foundation Subjects

In **History**, we will be learning about the events of WWII. In **Art**, we will be learning about William Morris. Towards the end of term, we will be covering an **RE** topic about Easter. In **Music** we will be practising our vocal skills. In **PE**, we are continuing to develop our badminton skills and improving our fitness.
