## Mathematics

By the end of Year 4 the children need to be fluent with all their times table and division facts. Please practise these as much as possible at home through TTRS. This is also set as part of their home learning for 20 minutes per week. We complete the Multiplication Table Check (MTC) in the Summer term. The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics.

## Residential

We are super excited for our trip to Juniper Hall. The parent talk is on the 11<sup>th</sup> January at 5.30pm, where we will share all the information and answer any questions you may have. The children's learning is going to fully equip them with the key terminology that they are going to use whilst we are away. All their hard work will be presented to you in our year group assembly on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> February at 2pm, so please come along to enjoy a fantastic performance from the children.

#### **Online Safety**
