The Year 2 Curriculum	
English and Reading	Linked to our Geography topic, we will be creating a variety of poems based on the ocean. We will also be writing Costa Rican rainforest riddles. Linked to our Science topic, we will be writing our own newspaper report based on The Tale of Peter Rabbit. During our reading lessons, we will be looking at the books <i>Costa Rica, Wild World and There's a Snake in my School</i> .
Maths	We will be starting the term with shape and then we will recap the four operations, which are <b>addition</b> , <b>subtraction</b> , <b>multiplication</b> and <b>division</b> . After half term, we will move onto position and direction. In line with what happens in Year 3, we will be sending home completed arithmetic quizzes for your information.
Science	Our learning this term will be all about living things and their habitats.
