We have an exciting new challenge for the children to complete over the May half term! The 'Smarties Challenge' is a fun and rewarding fundraiser and a new way to help us raise funds for the school that we hope the children will enjoy. As always, participation is optional.

Linking into the school value of Responsibility, we would like the children to collect as much change as they can in their Smarties tube, in return for being helpful or doing jobs/tasks for family and friends. 1p, 5p, 10p, 20p and £1 coins fit inside the Smarties tube and it is up to you to determine what each helpful task is worth (please only give what you can afford).

#### **How does it work?**

1. Eat your Smarties (or allergy alternative)!
2. Keep the tube - you will need this to put the coins in!
3. Fill up the tube with coins in return for being kind and helpful to family and friends - this can be any kind of helpful action you would like but some examples are being kind to others, helping to clear the table, helping to put clothes away, helping to wash the car etc.
4. Use the envelope to put your Smarties tube in and hand in at drop off on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June - there will be a collection bucket at the gate.
