Forest School

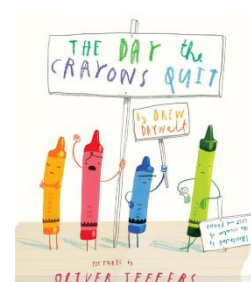
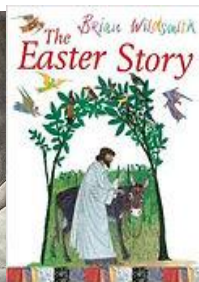
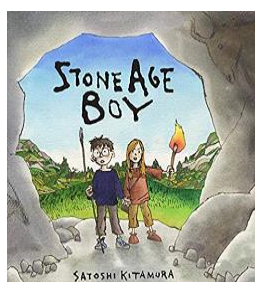
On Tuesdays we will have Forest School. See separate letter for information and please ensure your child has the correct clothing.

Curriculum

History - We will be learning about the Stone Age era. Exploring all that there is to know about survival through gathering and hunting, looking at types of settlements and diving into theories about Stone Henge. English (Writing) - This term, we will be writing a Stone Age non-chronological report, be applying what we learnt in Place Value of Punctuation, write a narrative set in Ancient China and do some persuasive writing using the book 'The Day the Crayons Quit' as inspiration.

RE - This term we will be learning about what Easter means to Christians, focusing on the events of Palm Sunday and why it is celebrated.

PE - Our topic will be dance, developing our skills and creating our own group routines to perform. We will also be working on our hockey skills outdoors.

DT - The children will be designing, creating and evaluating some Stone Age jewellery within Design Technology this term.

Science - Our learning this term will be about plants, as well as animals, including humans.
