Things to remember

Home Learning

Home learning this half term will focus on MyMaths, spellings and creative tasks. Children will be set 2 tasks on MyMaths every fortnight. Tasks will be set on a Thursday. Children will be sent one spelling task every week (on a Thursday) and these should be completed in their Spelling books. The creative tasks will follow the same format as previous years; the children will get to choose from a variety of different tasks linked to their learning.

Year 5 should be fluent in all of their multiplication and related division facts – all children are encouraged to use TT Rockstars to practise these.

PE

Year 5 will PE on a **Wednesday** and **Thursday**. Please can children come dressed in their PE kits on these days.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child brings in a filled, named water bottle each day.

CGP Guides

In Year 5, we are encouraging the children to be independent learners and use their CGP guides within lessons. Please can these come into school with them to facilitate this. They can be purchased on Scopay.

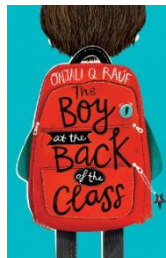


Year 5 Items

Curriculum

Our topic this term is 'Into The Unknown'. We are so excited to learn about our Solar System as well as finding out about Shackleton's famous journey to the South Pole. We are particularly looking forward to some exciting science investigations on our theme of forces. In English we will be developing our descriptive writing, taking inspiration from a short film called 'Trailblazer In Space.'

In Autumn 1, some of our reading lessons will be based around the book 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' by Onjali Q Rauf. In Autumn 2, we will be studying 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. You may like to purchase your child their own copy to refer to in lessons. We will also be looking at a range of non-fiction texts.



Reading books

Please continue to hear your child read on a daily basis/ensure your child reads independently. **Nothing** you can do at home is more important than this. Home reading will be celebrated in class. Children receive 1 STARS point for every read recorded in their planner. We will visit the library every two weeks, children are able to borrow one library book at a time.

Planners

Planners should be used to record home reading, but also to keep track of homework tasks, key dates and other information. Therefore, the children should have their planners in school **every day**. As always, we ask you to check and sign their planners weekly. Planners will be checked in school every Monday.
