Our Curriculum

English

This term, we will be developing our fictional writing skills by creating texts of different genres for a variety of purposes and audiences. We will be starting with a much-anticipated unit on suspense writing, which will be followed by a piece linked back to the popular WWII topic called The Piano.

Mathematics

Our focus will be on problem solving. If you would like to do any extra learning with your child, there are booklets on the website organised by topic.

Science

After May half term, we will be learning about the heart as well as the changes to the body and how to stay safe and keep healthy. This science unit will link with our PSHE and RSE lessons.

Foundation Subjects

The summer term is going to take us on a whistle-stop tour of Argentina in our Geography unit, while in Art we will be learning about the origins of graffiti. In Spanish, our focus will be comics inspired by Mafalda. Later in the term, we will cover our RSE unit alongside PSHE, with a focus on preparing for the move to Secondary School. In PE, we will be developing our skills in tennis and athletics and in Computing we will be using different programs to design and code our own games.
