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# Arrangements

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## SATs week – the important details!

- Wellbeing is important this week.
- PE kit can be worn all week.
- The tests only take up a small part of the day (apart from Wed).

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# SATs results

- WTS (working towards the standard)
- EXS (working at the expected standard – met)
- GDS (working at greater depth within the expected standard – still ‘classed’ as met).
- WTS, EXS and GDS raw scores – matched to scaled scores.
- Threshold scores change every year (depending on the ‘difficulty’ of the test).
- Results in July – shared with the summer term report.

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# Teacher Assessment

- Writing:
- Children are building a portfolio of writing in class.
- Used to assess their writing skills.
  - working towards the expected standard (WTS).
  - working at the expected standard (EXS).
  - working at greater depth within the expected standard (GDS).
- Writing may be externally moderated.

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# Teacher Assessment

- Science:
  - working at the expected standard (met).
  - working towards the expected standard (has not met).

Not based on tests.

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# Setting at Secondary School

- Secondary Schools receive SATs scores.
- Secondary Schools conduct their own testing procedures at the start of Year 7.
- There is a lot of collaboration between us and Secondary schools but they make the final decisions.

- Independence to manage a timetable and homework.
