Dear Parents/Carers of children in Reception and Year 6,

Throughout the second half of the Summer term (starting on Tuesday 2nd June), your child will get the chance to take part in Forest School education as part of our broad and balanced Langshott curriculum.

Reception and Year 6 will take part in their Forest School sessions on the following days:

Reception	Mondays
Year 6	Wednesdays (No Forest School during residential week and Forest School will move to Tuesday 7th July instead of Wednesday 8th July due to production.)

To ensure that your child can participate safely with Forest School activities, they will need to have the following items in school on their set day/days:

- a **lightweight, waterproof coat**
- **waterproof trousers**
- a **pair of wellington boots**
- a **light-weight, long-sleeved top to protect arms from scratches and stings when the weather is too hot for waterproofs** (this could be a school jumper/cardigan/hoodie/Zoodie or other)
- **light-weight, long trousers/joggers/leggings to protect legs from scratches and stings when the weather is too hot for waterproofs** (this could be school trousers/PE joggers or other)
- a **sun hat.**

For ease, these items *can* be left at school for the duration of the half term if you wish. **As ever, please ensure all items are named appropriately.**

Please also ensure that your child has **adequate sun protection** by applying long lasting sun cream before school as you normally would in the Summer term.
