



Home Learning Information – Summer Term 2 2026 for Parents / Carers of Children in Reception

Thank you for your continued support with home learning, we are so proud of the children! In Summer 2, home learning will focus on reading, NumBots and a new creative task to support the children with their transition to Year 1.

Reading

Please continue to hear your child read **daily**. Children take two books home per week:

- A Rhino Reader book (changed weekly). Your child should read this every day to improve fluency. We award STARS points for daily reading. Please make sure to record every read in your child's yellow reading record.
- A reading for pleasure book (changed daily).

NumBots

Children should play regularly for short bursts so we recommend 5 minutes, four times a week. Please support your children with questions if they find them tricky.

Creative Task

Children will have the opportunity to work on some different home learning tasks, similar to the rest of the school. Children will bring home a new purple home learning book on the 4th June, with a sheet inside, outlining the tasks that they will complete of their own choice. Resources to support you at home with this will be uploaded to Google Classroom. Children will be shown the tasks before coming home. They will need to complete a **minimum of two** home learning activities by the 7th July, of course, they can do more if they wish! This should be presented in their purple home learning book. Purple home learning folders will be sent home too, these can be kept at home.

The creative tasks should be completed in addition to the reading and NumBots home learning.

Home learning will be enjoyed and celebrated in class and across year groups at the end of term. Children will be given feedback in a variety of ways; including verbal feedback, written feedback, MarvellousMe badges or a Headteacher's award!
