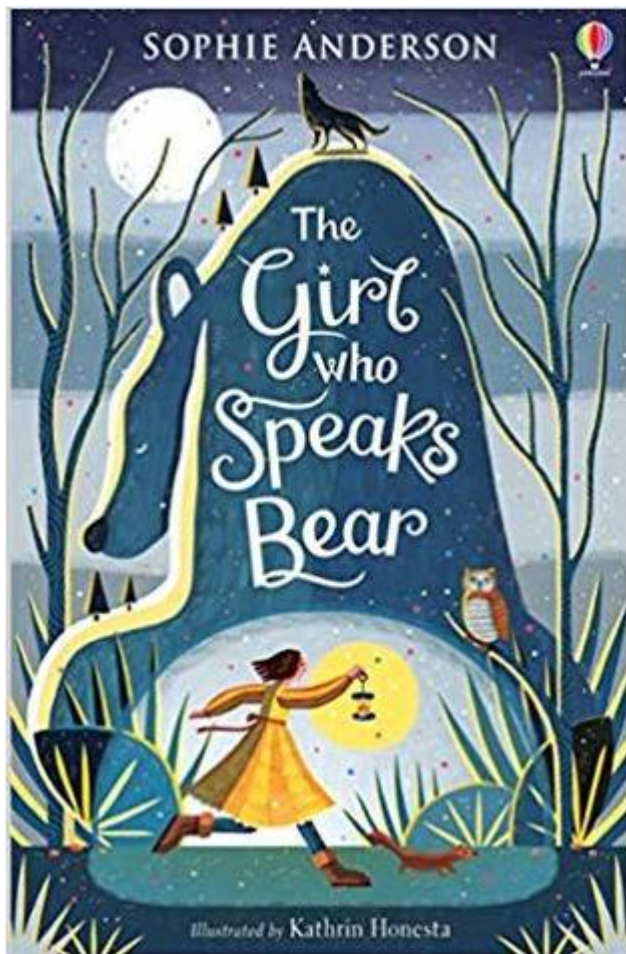


Miss Wesson recommends:
