### English (up to 1 hour)

**Phonics** – (15 minutes) play some of the free games on phonics play <https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/> such as buried treasure and Dragon’s Den (we ask that you request the log in details from your class teacher). You can also watch Geraldine the Giraffe and Tricky Word songs on YouTube (with the help of an adult).

**Reading** – (10 minutes) continue to read daily out loud to an adult and record in your reading diary. **Spellings** – (5 minutes) you can find weekly spelling on the Year 1 page of the school website. Please continue to practise these at home according to the correct date.
