For those that put a name to the survey, someone will contact you if you raised specific points.



Answered: 161 Skipped: 0






It is always pleasing to know that our children feel happy at Langshott, over 98% of those that replied either strongly agreed, or agreed. After all, they are at the heart of everything we do.




Most importantly, over 97% feel that their children are safe at school.

Q3: My child/ren has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively.










Over 81% strongly agreed or agreed that they were made aware of what their children were learning. However, there were some comments that information was inconsistent. Behind the scenes, we have been working very hard to create our new curriculum and have not wanted to share this until it was complete, so we acknowledge that there has been a gap here. Moving forward we will address this by sending out more regular information, regarding which topics each year group will be studying. 

Q6: Does your child have special educational needs and / or disabilities (SEND)?










At Langshott, we do have high expectations for our pupils and over 80% of those who responded agreed with this. However, there were some comments that said our expectations were too high and some that they were too low.






151 of those that responded agreed that the school offers a good range of subjects, with many welcoming the addition of our Forest School. Some would like to see more focus on science, music and PE. Others felt the curriculum was too narrow and there was not enough opportunity for pupils to read with teachers. We do follow the requirements of the National Curriculum for a 'broad and balanced curriculum', but ideally need more hours in the day to fit everything in that we would like to do.



Forest School was mentioned several times and seen as a welcome addition.





What We Will Do...

- Review the behaviour and anti-bullying procedures with all staff and remind children of our values and their responsibilities and the role they play in making our environment as safe, positive and friendly as possible. Whilst reviewing these procedures we need to discuss with our staff and children about recognising who to go to and when. We have anti-bullying week this week and have been looking at the difference between friendship issues and bullying and what the pupils should do if they feel they are being bullied or if they see another being bullied.
- School to reinforce to parents of SEN pupils that our SENDCO Mrs Mehta is available to talk to if they have concerns about SEN.
- ❖ Improve communication sent to parents about topics that are being taught and encouraging parents to read newsletters and visit the school website.
- Offer both face to face and virtual meetings for parent teacher meetings.
- ❖ Now the lockdown is over, renew our commitment to interschool sporting competitions.
- ❖ Compare these results with the pupil survey and act upon the pupil's feedback too.
