Dear Children and Parents in Year 1 from September 2022,

*We are really looking forward to welcoming you to Year 1. We have an exciting year ahead with lots of interesting topics and trips planned. Our trips include a visit to the British Wildlife Centre, the Brighton Toy and Model Museum, a local walk in Horley, as well as a whole school trip to watch a Pantomime at Christmas. We also have our wonderful Year 1 nativity and pirate day to look forward to. We cannot wait!*

In addition, here is some key information about routines and expectations in Year 1:

**1) WATER-BOTTLE:** It is important that children keep hydrated and drink **water** regularly through the day. Please provide your child with a water bottle and ensure this is clearly named and only ever filled with water.

**2) LEARNING PACK:** We will provide your child with a learning pack containing a pencil, glue stick, scissors, ruler, whiteboard and pen and a green pen, which they will keep at school.

**3) FRUIT:** We will continue to provide the children with a piece of fruit at break time.

**4) HOME LEARNING:** Home learning is set on Thursday and handed in on Tuesday. Spellings are sent out on a Thursday and the children are 'quizzed' on them the following week. The children are also expected to read regularly and play 20 minutes of Numbots each week.

**5) PE KIT:** The children are expected to wear their full PE kit to school on PE days.
