Outcome: to create a travel article to persuade people to visit Bilbao.

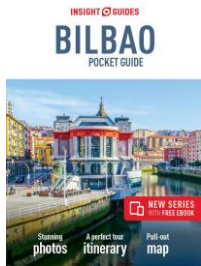
