Outcome: to write a comic strip based on Mafalda.

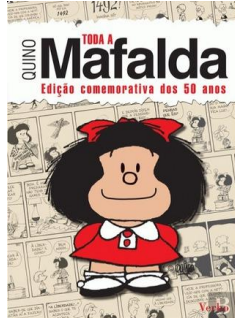
