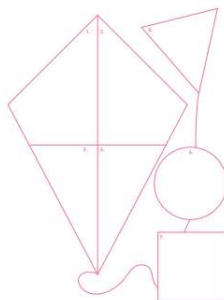


- To understand that bullying is sometimes about difference
